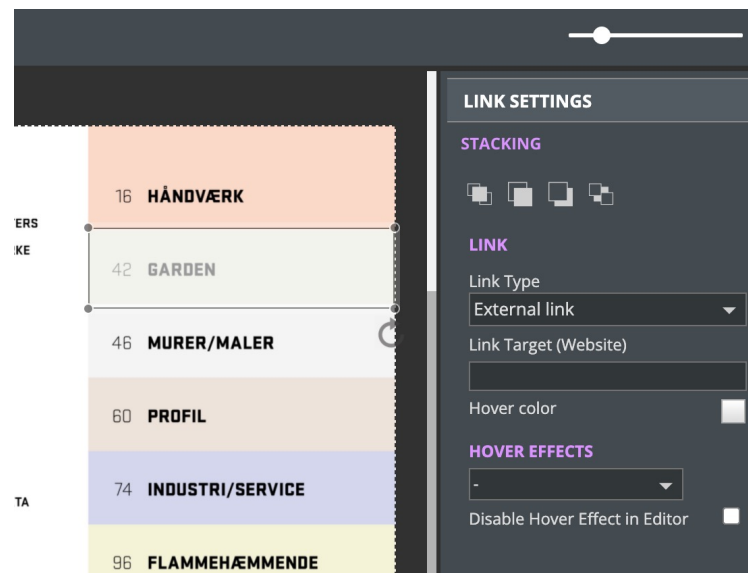
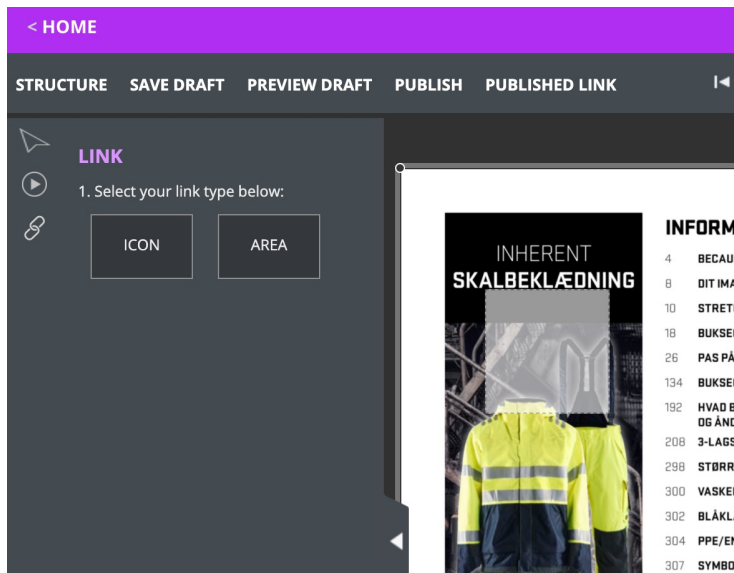

1.2) Link type; area

- Selecting "area" will open a link to the canvas
- "Link settings" will open to the right side

- Area can be modified by size and shape
- Dragging will allow you to freely move it



2.1) Link settings

- Settings are similar for icon and area

• Link Type

- Main types are:

- External (url-link)
- E-mail
- Phone number
- Internal link (to page...)

- Fill in the desired url

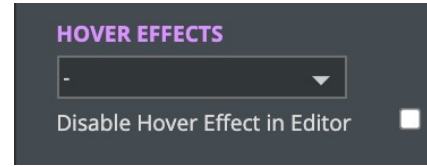
- You can also assign any area to be an internal index link; ie "to page 4"

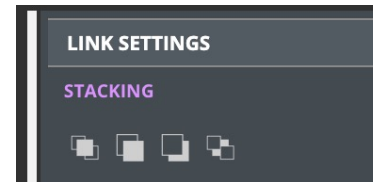
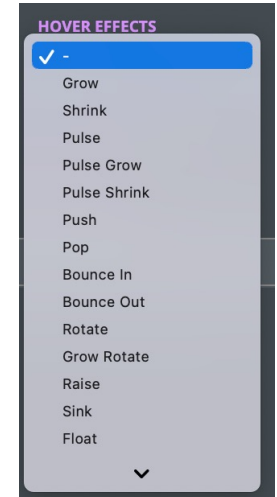
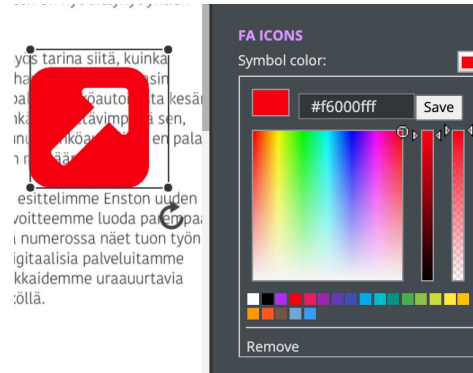

2.2) Link settings

- Hover effect
 - Select the effect. Effect activates when mouse is moved on top of the link
 - Hover does not work on mobile devices
- Icon color
 - Change the Icon color
 - Also possible by hexa code
- Stacking
 - If several links are on top of each other, here you can set their activity order



- Disabling effect in editor is useful if page contains volumes of hover effects. Editing becomes visually more pleasing



3) Saving and publishing

- **"Save draft"** saves changes but publication is not yet public
 - "Preview draft" allows you to see the changes
- **"Publish"** publishes all editing online and public
 - "Published link" opens the the actual online url

NOTE!

- You must save changes made, before leaving the page!
